**A Note To Parents About Baptism**

*Baptism in Water*

Baptism by immersion in water is commanded in the Scriptures (Mark 16:16). All who repent and believe on Jesus Christ as a personal Savior and Lord are to be baptized. This act of baptism symbolically declares to everyone that the old sinful life and life -style of the baptized believer died with Christ at salvation and a new spiritual being has been raised with Christ (in His resurrection) to live a new life (Matthew 28:19; Mark 16:16; Acts 10:47-48; Romans 6:4).

Water baptism is not simply a religious custom. It embodies the central message of the Christian faith. Water baptism is a one-time event in which the new believer announces publicly that he is now a child of God who has identified with Jesus Christ and His death and resurrection.
